About Acquired Brain Injury

More than 160,000 Australians are severely affected by acquired brain injury (ABI) and needed some form of personal assistance or supervision with every day living. The highest rate of cases in hospitals is for young people aged 15-19 years, with Queensland residents had the highest rate of traumatic brain injury-associated hospital admissions.

Acquired brain injury is injury to the brain which results in deterioration in cognitive, physical, emotional or independent functioning. Acquired brain injury may be due to a range of causes, including strokes, deprivation of oxygen (anoxic brain injury), degenerative diseases such as Alzheimer's Disease, an accident of some kind (traumatic brain injury) or excessive alcohol consumption.
